What does the Pregnancy Centre do?

The K-W Pregnancy Resource Centre is a non-profit organization committed to assisting individuals facing the challenges of an unplanned pregnancy.

They also support women who have experienced difficulties after an abortion. In their work, they have been coming alongside individuals in the community since 1986. They have learned much about the issues these women are facing and they can help.

The Centre supports women who make the decision to parent by providing a support group of Moms, and a care closet stocked with baby care items.

How can you help?

Have some fun by holding a baby shower! Many of the moms that come into the Centre do not have family support and the layette that the Centre gives them is greatly needed and appreciated.

A baby shower for the Centre usually occurs as a church group gets together for another occasion (bible study, ladies group etc.) and as part of that, they bring new items for layettes. A short presentation is usually given by a Centre staff person. There would not be any moms in attendance due to confidentiality considerations.
